1. When two people share one booth with two different products (for example: wood and sewing) each exhibitor must pay the application fee. A two-person team producing a single product may qualify as single exhibitor. Please explain the finished product .
2. Please submit three (3) close-up photographs or slides of ALL of your work & a SASE with this application. Your name must be on each picture if you want them returned.
3. In order for the Jamboree to maintain both quality and variety of works, the Committee will limit repetitions of the same crafts. If your work is not accepted, the application fee will be returned. The \$5.00 processing fee is non-refundable.
4. **No reselling of commercial products.** All arts and crafts are restricted to original works, designed and hand-crafted by the applying artist. Artist must be present at show. Pornographic\* material in any form is strictly prohibited. \*Committee holds the right to define pornographic. Clothing by invitation only.
5. Acceptance is a commitment to show during **both days** of the Jamboree. Artists not exhibiting both days will forfeit all award money won and will not be accepted in future shows. For safety purposes vehicles have to be moved off the show grounds no later than 8:30am Sat. & Sun. and will not be permitted back on the grounds until 5:15pm Sat, 4:15pm Sun after the show closes to the public
6. Space size will be approximately 10' X 12'. No electric hook-ups are available. Artists provide their own sturdy display racks, shelves, etc. Be prepared for sun, wind, rain, ants, and biting insects.
7. **NO REFUNDS FOR CANCELLATIONS.** No refunds in case of inclement weather.
8. Where appropriate, all work should be matted and framed for display. Unframed work may be offered in a portfolio. A minimum of 6 works must be displayed to be eligible for judging.
9. Previously received ribbons or awards from any other show cannot be displayed.
10. Artists are responsible for collecting and forwarding the 6.5% Florida Sales Tax to the Dept. of Revenue.
11. One monetary award per exhibitor. Committee members are ineligible for awards.
12. **ABSOLUTELY NO PETS !!!** They will **not** be allowed on Settlement grounds. Only fully trained and certified service animals with proof of certification will be permitted.
13. When any rule is violated, the Committee reserves the right to ask the offending artist to leave the show or remove said offense or violation.
14. The Settlement is not responsible for loss or damage, or for exhibits left overnight.
15. All artists' vehicles must park in the assigned parking area, no parking on show grounds. This and all rules will be strictly enforced by Settlement staff and specially assigned volunteers.
16. Deadline for all entries is when the SHOW IS FULL. Register early, as spaces fill quickly.
17. No overnight camping, even in self-contained vehicles, will be allowed. Various camping facilities are located near by.
18. Additional information concerning set-up procedures will be sent to accepted artists.
